Champagne Supernova

GH2O fans Boris Terwey and Arndt Gaube drove 7500 km around the Baltic Sea to raise money to a fund a well. The Baltic Sea Circle Winter is a rally race for a "special" breed of race driver. It takes place at the end of February and lasts about 15 days. The 7500 km course takes teams through the ice, snow, and short days including no less than 10 countries in northern Europe.

This year, Team Champagne Supernova (Boris and Arndt), named Global H2O as its official charity, initially with a modest goal of raising €3000. That goal was reached before the race started, so the team raised the bar to €7000 - the cost of one turnkey water well in Africa. Then, during the race, the €7000 mark was busted, but the donations kept coming in! By the time the team crossed the finish line in Hamburg, a whopping €9400 had been collected and transferred to Global H2O!

Global H2O plans to build a well in honor of Team Champagne Supernova donors in the next few months, most likely in a refugee camp in northern Uganda. The additional money will be used to rehabilitate an existing well. All together, the efforts of team Champagne Supernova and the generosity of over 80 donors will be enough to supply over 4000 people in Africa with clean water!
